

报告人简介:



David Harper, a professor emeritus at Durham University and a guest research professor at NIGPAS, is an internationally well known geologist and palaeontologist specialized in Early Palaeozoic brachiopods, stratigraphy, and beyond. For about 60 years, he has published over 10 books and monographs, and over 300 peer reviewed research papers. He is one of the major initiators of the famous and very useful software package PAST. When he was working at Copenhagen University, he was elected as a foreign member of the Royal Danish Academy of Sciences. He was former President of the International Paleontological Association (IPA) (2010-2014), Chair of the International Commission on Stratigraphy (ICS) (2016-2024), and Chair of the International Subcommission on Ordovician Stratigraphy (ISOS) (2012-2020). Prof. Harper started his collaborations with Chinese colleagues in 1980s, and has published over 30 collaborative papers and monographs since then. He was honored an Einstein Professorship by the Chinese Academy of Sciences in 2012.
