ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The Cambrian Period represents a critical time interval in the evolutionary history of the Earth-life system, which was characterized by the explosive radiation of animal phyla and subsequent extinctions of biodiversity in a fluctuating environmental background. The co-evolution of life and environment in the early history of the animal world during the Cambrian holds profound significance for addressing the global changes in the deep time and at present.

During the Cambrian, [the Xiangxi area in western Hunan Province, China](#), was in a deep-water transitional zone from the outer continental shelf to the continental slope of the Yangtze Block, far away from the shallow-water platform environments. This distinctive slope-facies depositional setting makes the Xiangxi area a key region for studying the stratigraphic record, biological evolution, and environmental changes in the Cambrian. Two Cambrian Global Boundary Stratotype Sections and Points (GSSPs)—those of the Guzhangian Stage and the Furongian Series/Paibian Stage—have been established in the Xiangxi area and as the major components of the Xiangxi UNESCO Global Geopark. More recently, the exceptionally preserved Huayuan biota from the Cambrian Stage 4 was discovered from the Huayuan County of Xiangxi, revealing a highly diverse ecosystem dominated by soft-bodied animals following the first Phanerozoic mass extinction—the Sinsk event.





The Nanjing Institute of Geology and Palaeontology, Chinese Academy of Sciences (NIGPAS) was founded in 1951, with its root in the former Palaeontological Section, Institute of Geology (Academia Sinica) and in the Paleontological Group of the Geological Survey of China. The founding director of NIGPAS was Prof. Li Siguang (J. S. Lee), a distinguished geologist and palaeontologist. NIGPAS conducts basic and applied research in palaeontology (invertebrate palaeontology and palaeobotany) and stratigraphy and is the only Chinese institution that specializes in these fields. The institute currently focuses on the origin and evolution of life on earth, evolutionary palaeontology, biostratigraphy and chronostratigraphy, systematic palaeontology, palaeoecology, palaeogeography and palaeoclimatology, molecular palaeobiology, geobiology, coevolution of life and environment, and applied palaeontology and stratigraphy.

To promote multidisciplinary research on the Cambrian Explosion and Extinctions, and to strengthen collaborations and communications among researchers worldwide, we are pleased to invite colleagues and students from all relevant research fields to attend the “[International Conference on the Cambrian Explosion and Extinctions](#)”, which will be held in Nanjing and Xiangxi, China from [November 1st to 6th, 2026](#) in memory of the 75th anniversary of the Nanjing Institute of Geology and Palaeontology, Chinese Academy of Sciences (NIGPAS).
